OUR PRIORITY IS SAFETY.

Please be aware of our guidelines that are in place to keep you and your group safe. Some are actual laws, but most are just common sense.

FIGHTING & VIOLENCE

- Let's all play nice. Fighting and violence is not tolerated. Anyone involved in a fight or altercation may be immediately removed from the trip at their own cost.
- No person shall impede the enjoyment or safety of others. Intimidation, including verbal, physical, or sexual harassment of any kind will not be tolerated.
- We believe in yes means yes, and ONLY yes means yes. No person shall engage in non-consensual sexual activity. Any form of sexual violence will not be tolerated.
- Serious injury or death can occur on balconies. Zero tolerance for horseplay on balconies.

RESPECT

- Respect all airlines, hotels, excursions, venues, and Ceremony Travel property.
- Be respectful of other guests. No Loud music between 10pm and 7am. No unnecessary noise in public areas of the hotel.
- Parties are NOT allowed in guest rooms, balconies or public areas.
- Smoking is only permitted in designated areas. No smoking in rooms, buses or flights.
- Tampering with safety devices, such as fire alarms and extinguishers, is strictly prohibited. Persons found tampering with such items will be removed from the Ceremony Travel Program and evicted without refund.

DRUGS & ALCOHOL

- Just SAY NO! Drug possession and use is ILLEGAL.
- Ceremony Travel follows a strict policy for alcohol possession and/or consumption. Only students who are 18 and over will be permitted to consume alcohol while on a trip with Ceremony. Those of age are expected to consume responsibly.
- Excessive use of alcohol can result in injury and severely impaired judgment. Ceremony does not condone the abuse of alcohol.

HOTEL ROOM DAMAGE

- You and your roommates are responsible for any and all damage to your room.
- Upon check-in, you will be provided with a 'Room Damages Form'. Make sure you take time to check your room and fill out and return your form.
- We get it, accidents can happen. This is why Ceremony Travel requires a \$60 CAD/USD security damage deposit, or the purchase of \$20 CAD/USD room damage protection in case of any accidental damages up to \$500 USD per room.

SWIMMING

- Water safety is extremely important. No swimming after sundown, and always swim with a buddy.
- Please note the posted pool and beach regulations, which are strictly enforced.
 Additionally, glass bottles and sharp objects are not permitted in these areas.
